MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING RAGSDALE/RRR PROPERTY MANAGEMENT, LLC DEVELOPMENT EAST OF VANN TO COO-Y-YAH AND SOUTH 5TH STREET

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is dated this ____ day of February 2020 and shall set forth the parties understanding concerning the completion of the first phase of a development of property which commenced approximately 2 years prior to this MOU. The property involved is the property belonging to RRR Property Management, LLC (herein RRR) located East of Vann To Coo-Y-Yah and South of 5th St.

WHEREAS, the development of the property commenced some time prior to this agreement and prior to the adoption of the City's current UDO and prior to changes in officials currently in office with the City and the Municipal Utility Department, and

WHEREAS, the development was began under City requirements that are now superseded by current codes, regulations and procedures, and

WHEREAS, the prior commitments, approvals and instructions for the development were made to RRR concerning the building out of the development and RRR commenced its development in reliance on same. 3 of the lots were completed with another 6 planned for completion, and

WHEREAS, the former commitments, approvals and instructions between the City and RRR were not memorialized in writing, but however the parties mutually desire to set forth same according to the contents of this MOU in order that each have a clear understanding of same so as to assure the completion of the development of the property in a mutually agreeable and beneficial manner to the mutual benefit of the City and RRR.

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES STATE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The development of the lots for size width and depth associated with the 280 feet of extension of 6th St. are to be similar to the existing 6 lots and the 3 lots previously approved for development all of which conform to the current UDO as "RD".
- 2. There are 6 lots associated with this current development plan. 3 on the north side of 6th St. extended and 3 on the south side of 6th St. extended.
- 3. There shall be a utility easement on the south side of the new lots located on the south side of 6^{th} St. extended.
- 4. The existing utility easement coming onto the property from the north which would run through
 - the middle of one of the new lots, is to be closed and vacated in accordance with city regulations and state law and a new utility easement shall be provided on the west side of the western most lot on the north side of 6th St. The size of the utility easement shall be per MUB requirements. The Developer shall provide all legal descriptions for the new easement and pay for all costs associated with closing and vacating the existing utility easement.
- 5. The Right of Way for 6th St. shall be the same width as the existing Right of Way for 6th St. and extended 280 feet to the end of the pavement or to the end of the eastern most lots both north and south. The Developer shall prepare this Right of Way legal description and exhibit for dedication to the City of Pryor and same shall be dedicated and conveyed by dedication deed to the City for street and utility purposes.
- 6. The 6th St. extension roadway shall be in accordance with the standard residential asphalt street construction as provided to the contractor in a detail set of plans prepared by the City Engineer, a copy of that plan is attached to this outline.
- 7. The City will provide the driveway drainage pipes to be located on each of the 6 lots

- being developed by this plan. The placement of those drain pipes, the backfill around those pipes and insurance that each pipe is lain on grade to drain is the responsibility of the Developer.
- 8. The Developer agrees that any future development beyond the current 6 lots and the existing 3 lots whether residential or commercial shall carried out in compliance with all the City's codes, ordinances, regulations and procedures for development of property in the City which includes but is not necessarily limited to being preceded by a plat of the remaining property including restrictive covenants, rights of way, easements, and lot layout in accordance with zoning associated with the property. Any zoning changes must be made prior to any further development.
- 9. The long-term plan must include provisions for onsite detention of stormwater in accordance with the UDO of the City of Pryor. Fee in lieu of report may be substituted for the detention if it is determined to be feasible.
- 10. A Second Access point to the remaining property shall be included in the long-term plan which may include an emergency only access gate and path from S. Coo-Y-Yah St.
- 11. All future utility extensions for water, sewer, streets and drainage shall be designed and installed by the Developer at developers cost and then be dedicated to the city within fully identified utility easements.
- 12. The Plat shall identify the 6 lots of this development plan as well as the 3 lots previously approved and be shown as "Existing Lots Established Previously" on the face of the Plat along with legal Descriptions covering each of the existing lots. Warranty Deeds for each of these lots shall be updated to show the inclusion of the lot in the Long-Term Plat.
- 13. The development of the 6 lots under this MOU shall be completed within one (1) year of the date of this MOU.
- 14. This MOU shall only be effective when approved by the City Council, City Engineer and RRR.
