MINUTES BUDGET AND PERSONNEL REGULAR MEETING TUESDAY, OCTOBER 10TH, 2023 5:30 P.M.

THE BUDGET AND PERSONNEL COMMITTEE MET IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER AT 12 NORTH ROWE STREET, PRYOR, OKLAHOMA AT THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME.

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

The meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m. by Dennis Nance. Members present: Dennis Nance, Charles Tramel and Travis Mileur. Members absent: Choya Shropshire.

Others present: Zac Doyle, Terry Aylward, Justin Couch, Jeremy Cantrell and Kevin Tramel.

2. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 12^{TH} , 2023 REGULAR MEETING.

Motion was made by Tramel, second by Mileur to approve the minutes of the September 12^{th} , 2023 regular meeting. Voting yes: Nance and Tramel. Abstaining, counting as a no vote: Mileur. Voting no: none.

3. MAYOR'S REPORT:

a. Tax Reports.

Doyle read the Tobacco, Sales and Use Tax reports.

b. Review of Financial Status.

Doyle stated that tax revenue is up slightly compared to the previous month and trending upward overall.

c. General Fund Budget Review.

Doyle stated the August report is not yet finished, however Councilors should keep in mind that many annual expenses incurred at the beginning of the Fiscal Year will be covered as the year progresses.

4. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY RECOMMEND COUNCIL ACTION REGARDING A GRANT FROM GRDA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,375.00 FROM PARKS CAPITAL OUTLAY ACCOUNT #44-445-5415 TO MODIFY THREE TENNIS COURTS TO ACCOMMODATE CREATING PICKLEBALL COURTS. THIS GRANT WILL REIMBURSE THE CITY FOR A \$1,050.00 EXPENDITURE TO MERRITT TENNIS AND TRACK SYSTEMS TO INSTALL LINES IN THE PLAY AREA, A \$556.00 EXPENDITURE TO CHAMPION CONCRETE TO COVER THE COST OF CREATING CORE HOLES FOR POSTS TO BE PLACED AND A \$2,769.00 EXPENDITURE TO TCS TO COVER THE COST OF NETS AND OTHER HARDWARE. THESE EXPENDITURES WILL BE REIMBURSED IN FULL UPON COMPLETION BY THE GRDA GRANT FUNDS.

Motion was made by Mileur, second by Tramel to recommend Council action regarding a grant from GRDA in the amount of \$4,375.00 from Parks Capital Outlay Account #44-445-5415 to modify three tennis courts to accommodate creating pickleball courts. This grant will reimburse the city for a \$1,050.00 expenditure to Merritt Tennis and Track Systems to install lines in the play area, a \$556.00 expenditure to Champion Concrete to

cover the cost of creating core holes for posts to be placed and a \$2,769.00 expenditure to TCS to cover the cost of nets and other hardware. These expenditures will be reimbursed in full upon completion by the GRDA Grant funds. Voting yes: Tramel, Mileur and Nance. Voting no: none.

5. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY RECOMMEND COUNCIL ACTION TO AMEND OR RESCIND A CITYWIDE HIRING FREEZE IF THE CITY COUNCIL DETERMINES CITY FINANCES ARE STABLE ENOUGH TO RESPONSIBLY CONSIDER HIRING NEW EMPLOYEES.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014 - 10

RESOLUTION OF STATEMENT OF INTENT OF THE CITY OR PRYOR CREEK, OKLAHOMA REGARDING THE USE AND ALLOCATION OF HOTEL/MOTEL TAX REVENUES

WHEREAS, in May of 1998, there was lawfully established and codified a HOTEL/MOTEL TAX ORDINANCE codified and set forth in the ordinances of the City of Pryor Creek as Chapter 2, Sections 2-2A-1 through Sections 2-2A-23.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the lawfully adopted provisions the use of the funds generated from said tax are to be used for: City development activities and/or events identified by the Hotel/Motel Tax Allocation Board and approved by the City Council.

WHEREAS, for purposes of clarification, coordination and to promote guidance in the orderly and efficient administration of efforts of the Hotel/Motel Tax Allocation Board and the City Council in the furtherance of the purposes of said ordinance, the City Council deems it advisable and appropriate to set forth this resolution as a demonstration of intention and supported policy for guidance in the common unification of efforts and goals to be pursued, to-wit:

- a. To promote and foster tourism, conventions, special events and trade shows in the City;
- b. To encourage the development of the City as a convention, trade show, and tourist center;
- c. To construct, reconstruct, operate, maintain and repair buildings and facilities to encourage the development of the City, and to foster the development of the City as a convention, trade show, and tourist center.
- d. To promote and encourage the revitalization of the City's downtown area thru appropriate efforts including but not limited to such opportunities as the Oklahoma Main Street Program and matching grant opportunities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma expresses its support for purposes of clarification, coordination and to promote guidance in the orderly and efficient administration of efforts towards the following goals in furtherance of the purposes of said Hotel/Motel Tax Ordinance:

a. An allocation of 40% of available funding for the promotion of the City of Pryor Creek through the local area Chamber of Commerce to support events sponsored by the Pryor Area Chamber of Commerce.

- b. An allocation of 20% of available funding for the support of Pryor Public School special events determined to be had by the Pryor Public Schools Administration inclusive of, and as part of said 20%, a yearly allocation of a minimum of \$2,500.00 in support of the annual "Pryor Band Day" event.
- c. An allocation of 10% of available funding for the support the Main Street Program for the City of Pryor Creek under the Oklahoma Main street Program thru matching grants for revitalization and promotion of the Main Street Program corridor from the corner of US Hwy 69 and State Hwy 20, thence east along Graham Avenue to Elliott Street and also along Northeast or Southeast First Streets from US Hwy 69 going east to Coo-Y-Yah Street and all the connecting streets in between.
- d. An allocation of 30% of available funding, with 10% of the 30% being maintained in reserve, for the support and promotion of capital improvements through 100% matching grants to new and existing sports facilities that promote the City of Pryor Creek Oklahoma; With the exception that any one time special event may be allocated up to a level of the 10% reserve without any matching funds required.
