

AMENDED ORDER GRANTING SUMMARY JUDGMENT

This Order is made hereby amending the Court's previous Order Granting Summary Judgment, entered March 3, 2020. This matter comes before this Honorable Court upon Petitioner State of Oklahoma's Motion for Default Judgment. Petitioner State of Oklahoma appears by Assistant District Attorney Todd M. Wagner. Defendant appears not. The Court, having examined the facts, finds that:

1. This case was filed as a civil forfeiture action on May 31, 2019.

2. The State served Potential Claimant Brooke Mahan (maiden name Brook Englebright) via certified mail on June 15, 2021.

3. Potential Claimant Brooke Mahan filed Defendant's Response to Notice of Seizure and Intended Forfeiture and Motion to Release and Return All Seized Evidence to the Rightful Owner on July 29, 2019.

4. The State of Oklahoma filed its Motion for Summary Judgment ("Motion") on October 15, 2020.

5. Potential Claimant Brooke Mahan failed to respond to the State's Motion.

6. The Court has reviewed the evidence submitted by the State, and this Court finds by a preponderance of the evidence the above listed property is in fact proceeds derived from the illegal sales and/or distribution of controlled dangerous substances within the State of Oklahoma and is forfeitable pursuant to 63 O.S. \S 2-503(A)(6), (A)(7) and (B).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the following described property, and all interest gained therefrom, be and the same is hereby forfeited to the Pryor Creek Police Department, to be used in accordance with Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act: 2006 Ford Mustang, VIN#1ZVFT84N865200672.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Service Oklahoma is directed to take all necessary actions to transfer title to the above forfeited 2006 Ford Mustang, VIN#1ZVFT84N865200672, to the Pryor Creek Police Department.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF A PART OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (SW/4) OF SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 21 NORTH, RANGE 19 EAST OF THE INDIAN BASE AND MERIDIAN, MAYES COUNTY, OKLAHOMA INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PRYOR CREEK, OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING THAT THE NEWLY ANNEXED TERRITOR4Y BE ZONED "RM" (RESIDIENTAL MULTI-FAMILY); AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY.

COMING BEFORE the City Council for the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma, is the Petition for Annexation filed by PCO Holdings, LLC (herein PCO) in reference to the following:

SECTION 1: JURISDICTIONAL FACTS

A Petition for Annexation was filed with the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma on the 31st day of January 2024 by PCO. In said Petition for Annexation, PCO, requested that the City of Pryor Creek add the following described property into the corporate limits of the City:

The Petitioner, PCO, by way of its Petition for Annexation has properly requested and consented to the annexation of the above described territory to the City. The territory petitioned to be annexed is adjacent and contiguous to the City of Pryor Creek. The territory to be annexed is wholly owned by PCO and PCO is therefore the owner of all the value of the property comprising the territory proposed to be annexed.

The City of Pryor Creek finds that said property is adjacent and contiguous to the corporate limits of the City of Pryor Creek, is not part of any other incorporated municipality, and is owned by PCO. (Containing 7.5911 acres more or less)

And that the official zoning map of the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma, shall be amended to reflect the change in the boundaries resulting from this annexation. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to file and record a duly certified copy of this Ordinance, together with an accurate map or plat of the annexed property, in the office of the Mayes County Clerk and with the Ad Valorem Division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission, and to take appropriate measures to implement this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: ZONING

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF PRYOR CREEK, OKLAHOMA that pursuant to Section 10-1-10E of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma providing for the assignment of the zoning classification to territory annexed to the City, that the following described tract of land newly annexed into the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma is hereby classified as "RM" (Residential Multi-Family), to-wit: A tract of land situated in the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) Section 31, Township 21 North, Range 19 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Mayes County, Oklahoma, being more particularly described as follows towit:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of said SW/4, THENCE North 88⁰28'26" East for a distance of 1162.71 feet along the South line of said SW/4; THENCE North 88⁰25'43" East for a distance of 999.72 feet along said South Line; THENCE North 1⁰34'176" West for a distance of 240.50 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE South 88⁰25'43" West for a distance of 877.10 feet; THENCE North 1⁰34'17" West for a distance of 158.49 feet; THENCE north 59⁰12'09" East for a distance of 823.28 feet; THENCE South 30⁰50'53" East for a distance of 157.63 feet; THENCE North 88⁰26'15" East for a distance of 81.53 feet; THENCE South 1⁰34'17" East for a distance of 422.96 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. SECTION 4: REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY

If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.
