A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ELIGIBILITY OF THE CITY OF PRYOR CREEK TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OKLAHOMA OPIOID ABATEMENT BOARD TO FUND THE PRYOR OPIOID ABATEMENT INITIATIVE IN PRYOR CREEK, OKLAHOMA AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THIS APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma, is submitting an application to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board in the amount of \$60,000.00 as set forth by in the 2020 Oklahoma House Bill 4138, the Political Subdivisions Opioid Abatement Grants Act.

WHEREAS, the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma is participating as an eligible project sponsor in the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board; and

WHEREAS, Federal monies are available under the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board to implement a multifaceted Opioid Abatement Initiative that will fund overtime pay for an Opioid Liaison Officer to spearhead community outreach, education and prevention and connect residents to treatment options and community resources; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma, acknowledges availability of the required local match of no less than \$0.00, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pryor Creek approves the submission of the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRYOR CREEK, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma does hereby authorize the Chief of Police to submit an application to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board on behalf of the citizens of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2: That the Chief of Police of the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma, is authorized to sign the application and submit additional information as may be required and act as the official representative of the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma, in this and subsequent related activities to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board on behalf of the citizens of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma.
