# MINUTES PARK BOARD REGULAR MEETING MONDAY, MAY 24<sup>TH</sup>, 2021 5:30 P.M.

THE PARK BOARD MET IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, 12 NORTH ROWE STREET, PRYOR, OKLAHOMA AT THE ABOVE-MENTIONED DATE AND TIME.

### 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

Kannegiesser called the Park Board meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Members present: Bill Kannegiesser, Pat Richard, Lori Siever, Chris Graves and Keith Shelby. Members absent: Melinda Marks and Casey King.

Others present: Mayor Larry Lees, Park Superintendent Frank Powell and Terry Aylward.

### 2. PETITIONS FROM THE AUDIENCE.

There were no petitions.

## 3. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE APRIL 26<sup>TH</sup>, 2021 REGULAR MEETING.

Motion was made by Shelby, second by Siever to approve the minutes of the April  $26^{th}$ , 2021 regular meeting. Voting yes: Siever, Graves, Shelby. Abstaining, counting as a no vote: Kannegiesser and Richard.

### 4. PARK REPORT – SUPERINTENDENT FRANK POWELL:

### a. Parks

Powell reported that there has been a delay on the restrooms at Whitaker Park regarding completion of the roof. Once the roofer is able to complete his job, the rest should go smoothly and quickly. He reported that some children have been causing issues at the park.

Powell stated that he has included in next year's budget to redo the tennis courts and add a pickleball court and new parking. He also stated that they still plan to work on Bobby Buck Park after Memorial Day, but since we have had so much rain, there will be a lot of mowing to catch up on.

### b. Cemetery

Powell reported that the cemeteries are ready for Memorial Day; however, the road crew has not gotten started on fixing the roads. The original plan was to have the roads completed by Memorial Day, but it does not appear that will happen. Richard stated that the cemeteries look very nice. Powell stated that they have had very few complaints lately, compared to years past, and the area that flooded so badly last year is dry.

# 5. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY RECOMMEND COUNCIL ACTION REGARDING THE SEASONAL OPENING OF THE WHITAKER PARK SWIMMING POOL.

Motion was made by Shelby, second by Richard to recommend Council action not to open the Whitaker Park Swimming Pool this season.

Powell stated that the engineer's estimate is approximately \$90,000.00 just for the deep-end concrete repair. He stated that it will cost \$120,000.00 - \$150,000.00 to get it up and running for the season. The lifeguard stands are in bad shape and will cost \$30,000.00 to replace. On top of the costs for repair, no one has applied for the managerial position or lifeguard positions.

Kannegiesser feels it is time to stop pouring money into a 65-year-old pool and start putting money into a new one. Powell stated that the state inspector did not recommend putting a new pool back in the same place as the current one. There is no doubt that the community wants an outdoor pool. It is true that the current pool can be repaired, but we do not know exactly how much it would cost and it would still just be a temporary fix.

Mayor stated that it would be good to begin discussion at next month's Park Board meeting to determine the course of action going forward. Graves stated that he would like to see a cost estimate on how much has been spent over the last several years on repairs. Powell stated that his crew and he have done most of the repair work, so most of the cost would be in their own labor.

Voting yes: Richard, Siever, Graves, Shelby, Kannegiesser. Voting no: none.

### 6. GOLF COURSE REPORT - DIRECTOR DENNIS BOWMAN

Bowman sent a written report in his absence, included in the minutes.

### 7. UNFORESEEABLE BUSINESS.
