

**MINUTES
STREET COMMITTEE

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 23RD, 2021
5:30 P.M.**

THE STREET COMMITTEE MET IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, 12 NORTH ROWE STREET, PRYOR, OKLAHOMA AT THE ABOVE-MENTIONED DATE AND TIME.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS: ** STEVE SMITH, RANDY CHITWOOD, JON KETCHER, YOLANDA THOMPSON (ALTERNATE)

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

The meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m. by Steve Smith. Members present: Steve Smith and Jon Ketcher. Members absent: Randy Chitwood.

Others present: Mayor Larry Lees, Buddy Glenn and Terry Aylward.

2. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 26TH, 2021 REGULAR MEETING.

Motion was made by Ketcher, second by Smith to approve the minutes of the January 26th, 2021 regular meeting. Voting yes: Smith and Ketcher. Voting no: none.

Chitwood arrived.

4. STREET SUPERINTENDENT REPORT – BUDDY GLENN.

Glenn reported that they survived the ice and snow of 2021. They have now replenished their salt and sand for the most part, in case any more weather moves in.

He reported that they had crews working day and night. They did most of their plowing at night and during the day they plowed what they could and worked slick spots. After all this was done, they did what they could to plow side streets, but this is a difficult task, with cars parked in the street.

He reported that the motor in one of the spreader trucks went out so they had to order new ones. The motors came in yesterday, so they will be getting the spreader repaired and have a spare for future needs. They have started running the street sweeper again. They also inserted a pipe on South Coo-Y-Yah by Jefferson School for a whistle for the new housing addition. They are back to trimming trees and once the melted snow subsides, they will go back to dipping ditches.

He reported that once the weather starts staying in the 50's and 60's they can get started on concrete sidewalk repair they need to do.

He was happy to report that no one got injured nor sick during the snow and ice.

He stated that he will be turning in a request tomorrow to replace an employee.

5. PRESENTATION OF NEW CITY MAP, REVIEW AND DISCUSSION OF PLANNED STREETS TO BE ADDRESSED IN NEXT STREET REHAB PROJECT.

Smith stated that they would postpone this presentation until Steve Powell can attend.

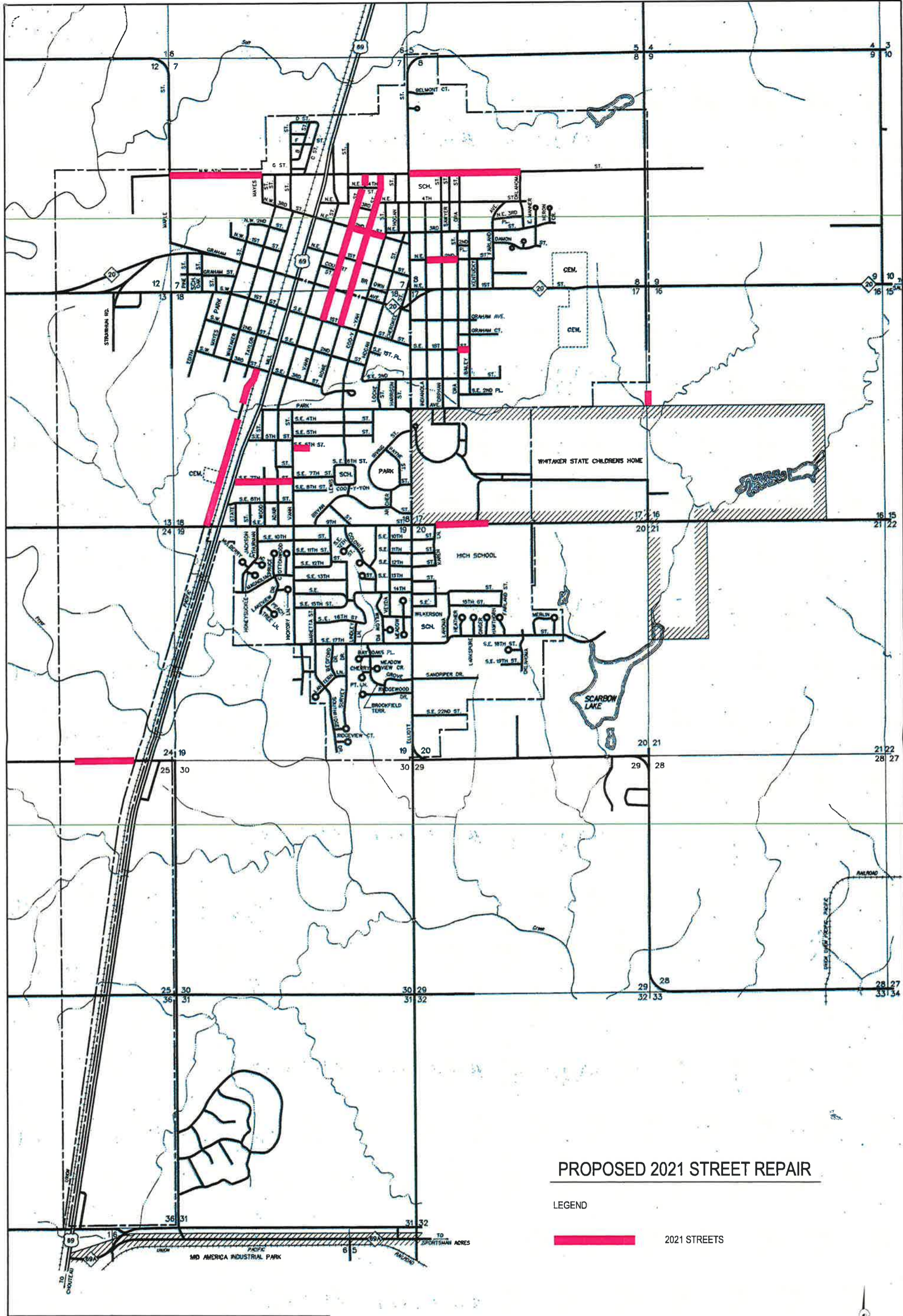
