3. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY RECOMMEND COUNCIL ACTION TO APPROVE FINAL EXPENSE REPORT FOR PRYOR AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE / PRYOR PATCHERS QUILT GUILD QUILT SHOW SEPTEMBER 17TH – 18TH, 2021, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000.00.

Sue Mayue presented the final expense report and answered questions of the Board. She reported that their total expenses were \$5,875.00, and their revenue was \$2,526.00 before expenses. She stated that they receive 20% of all revenue from the sale of artwork that she failed to include in the revenue total. She stated that they have other events during the year that create revenue to help in funding this event. This particular event is not a moneymaker; it is more about appreciation of artists and their art. All voted yes.
